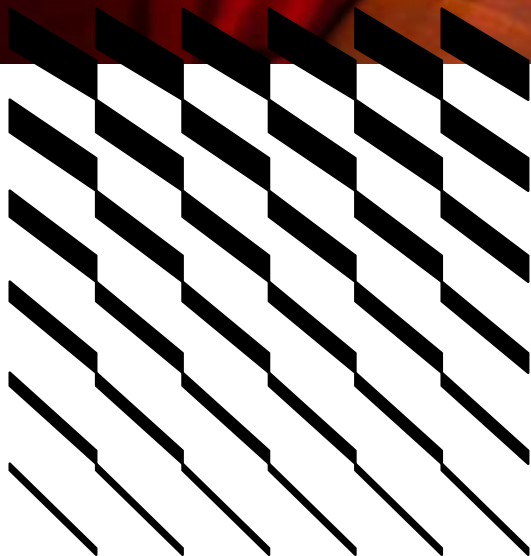

POWERFUL WOMEN

Across the Science Museum Group, sustainability is being put at the heart of all we do and is an integral part of our mission to Inspire Futures. We are transforming the way we work to take urgent action on the climate and nature crises. We have set a science-based target of achieving Net Zero carbon by 2033. We plan to reduce our emissions by 79% (against our 19/20 baseline year) through decarbonising operations at our six sites including our buildings, travel, waste, supply chain and investments.

SUSTAINABILITY

So far, we have made great progress by sourcing all our electricity from renewable energy contracts, made our museums more energy efficient, implemented a sustainable travel policy and planted 1000 native, locally sourced trees at our Science & Innovation Park since 2019. Our commitment to changing the way we work is outlined within the Group's Sustainability Policy.

Illuminate aims to make considerations for environmental sustainability at all stages of an event process through considering the impacts of operational decisions on carbon and nature.

90% Leaf Marque assured fruit and vegetables are sourced in Britain.



All meat is Red Tractor assured produce and 100% sourced in Britain.



Every tonne of food waste is recycled preventing approx. 1.0 tonne of CO2 entering the atmosphere.



All fish is recommended by the Marine Conservation Society (MCS).

All products are sourced from sustainable, certified, ethical trade or Fairtrade sources.

ARRIVING BY CAR

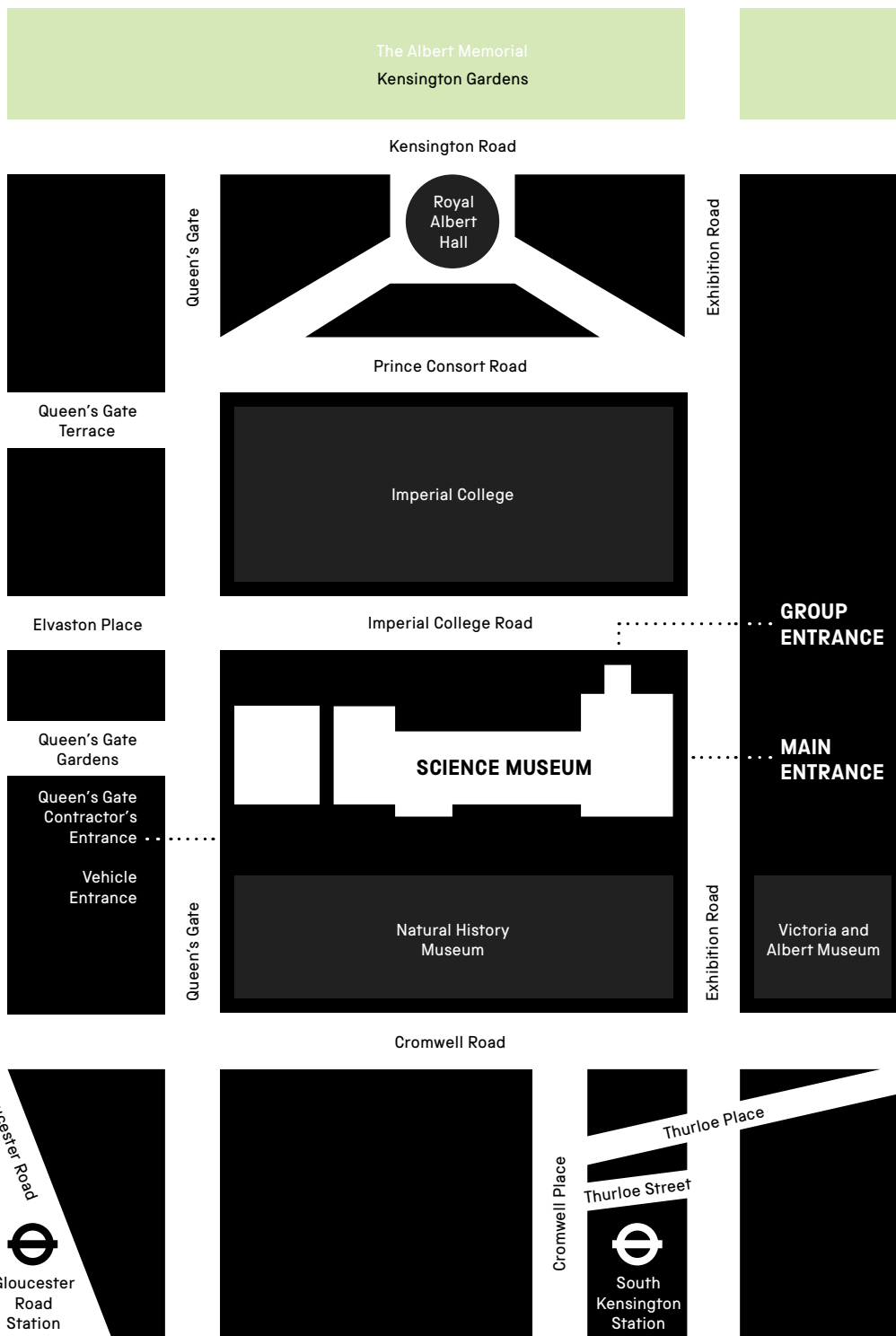
The nearest pay and display car parking is in Prince Consort Road and Queen's Gate.
